Scope and Content

The collection consists of records of the Model Cities Neighborhood Development Program.

HISTORICAL NOTE:

The Model Cities project included predominately 2500 acres pf residential property covering six neighborhoods. It included 35 townhouses built by Mt. Nebo Baptist Church, completion of the M. L. King Middle School, 18 scattered public housing units purchased; and 221 certificates for the 147 families whom purchased housing. Other completed projects included the Mt. Calvary residential development; Dunbar Neighborhood Center, Ralph McGill Elementary School, Georgia Hill Neighborhood Facility, Boynton Village townhomes, Phoenix Park, 60 units of family public housing and 81 units of elderly public housing.
