# Rawson-Washington Urban Renewal records. -- 1961-1967 and undated. -- 0.10 Cubic feet (Housed alphabetically with Individual Housing Projects--small collections)

# **Scope and Content**

The collection consists of project records and photographs relevant to the Rawson-Washington urban renewal project.

#### HISTORICAL NOTE:

Rawson-Washington entered execution July 1959 covering 353 acres at a net cost of \$13.1 million. It included the \$18 million Atlanta Stadium, a 405 unit motel, a 650 unit public housing project, a 192 unit M. L. King Jr. Village, and an elementary school. The site's tax value increased 1.5 times through redevelopment. The project officially closed out June 22, 1973. This project was part of the Interim Assistance Program. Atlanta Housing was working with Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to formulate a redevelopment plan to enhance living conditions in this area.
