## Samuel A. Hider papers. -- 1974-2004 and undated. -- 0.50 Cubic feet (1 box)

#### **Scope and Content**

The collection consists of biographical materials, speeches, and newspaper clippings regarding Samuel A. Hider, as well as other materials that formed a part of Hider's campaign to run for Vice President of the National Association of Housing and Redevelopment Officials (NAHRO) in 1985.

#### **BIOGRAPHY:**

Samuel A. Hider was one of ten children born in a small farming community in Gutherie, Oklahoma. While Hider was still a child, his family moved to East St. Louis, Illinois in a horse-drawn wagon. As a student, Hider organized the first band of his high school which featured the world renowned trumpeter, Miles Davis. Hider played the clarinet, alto and tenor sax. After highschool, Hider entered the U.S. Army where he served for three years during World War II in Italy and the North African Campaign.

After the war, Hider landed his first job at a fertilizing plant, which sparked his interest in the union movement. He attended the University of Wisconsin and the University of Illinois to prepare a career in the union field where he studied arbitration, contract negotiations, labor relations, grievance procedures, pensions, and welfare. Hider served as Special Representative for the United Mine Workers for twelve years in St. Louis. While working for the United Mine Workers, he met his wife Shirley in 1961. The United Mine Workers transferred Hider to Atlanta in 1964, and from here he traveled the South organizing locals including Cagle Poultry in Atlanta. His union work impressed the President of Cagle Poultry so much that he was offered a job there as personnel director in 1970. He worked at this position until, at the invitation of Mayor Maynard Jackson, Hider became the Director of the Bureau of Labor Relations in 1974.

On February 4, 1980, Hider came to work for Atlanta Housing as the Chief Administrative Assistant and on September 1,1980 he was named the Executive Director, a position he held until his retirement on July 31, 1990. During Hider's tenure, Atlanta Housing was removed from HUD's list of financially troubled public housing agencies, recognized for its homebuyers program, and selected as one of only twenty participants on the Housing Voucher Demonstration Program.

While Executive Director of Atlanta Housing Hider held many leadership roles and was active in several housing professional organizations including the Southeastern Regional Council of the National Association of Housing and Redevelopment Officials (NAHRO), the Georgia Association of Housing and Redevelopment where he served as Vice President for Housing, and the Public Housing Authorities Directors Association where he served as a trustee.
