SO, I DID. I CONTACTED ATLANTA HOUSING (AH) FOR HELP.

I found the perfect apartment near a park and public transportation. I asked for a reasonable accommodation for my service dog, but the landlord told me “no pets –try someplace else.” So I called Atlanta Housing and found out it’s illegal for a housing provider to prohibit service animals. I worked with the folks at Atlanta Housing, and now my dog and I have a great place to live.

Landlords must make reasonable accommodations for persons with disabilities, such as allowing for service animals or providing an accessible parking space.
